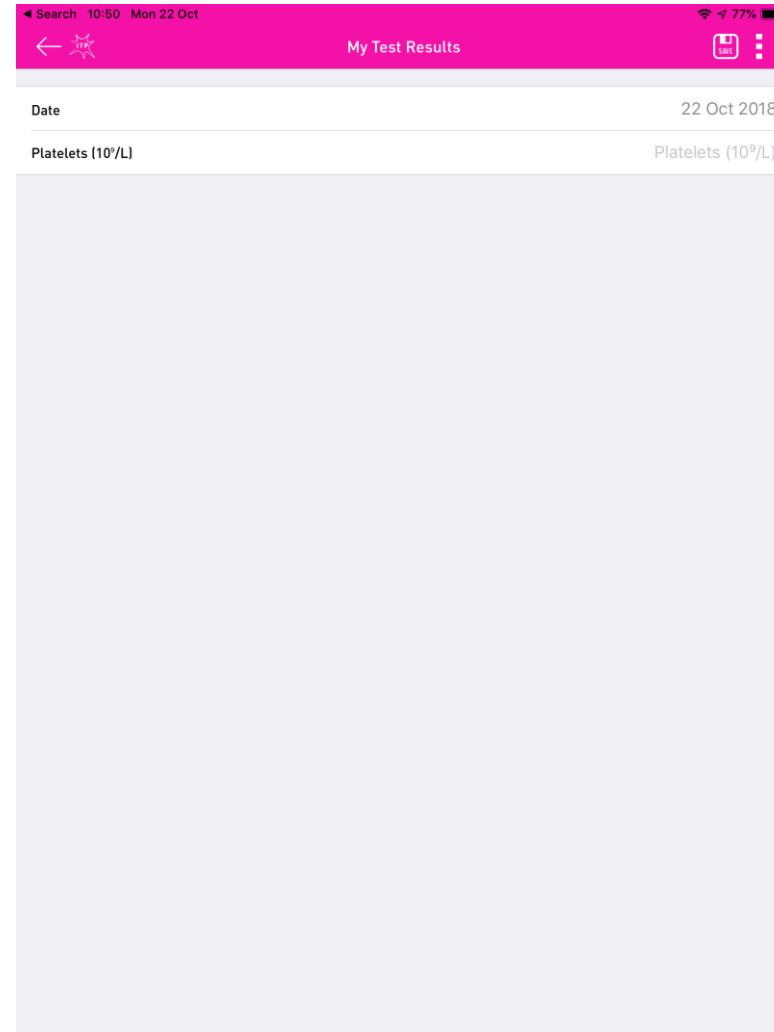
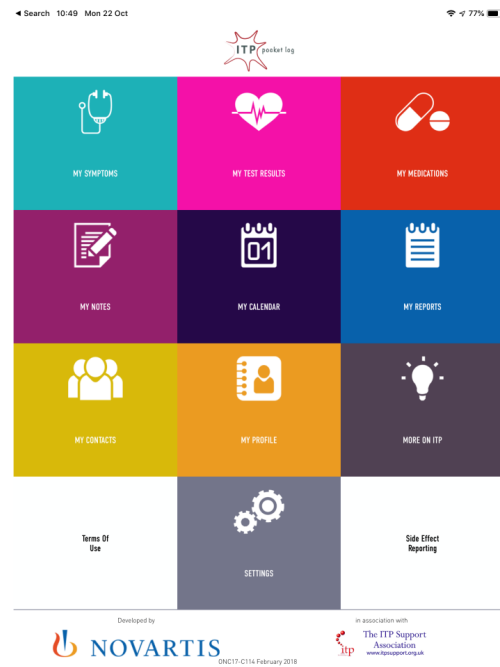
The ITP Pocket Log App 'Main Screen'



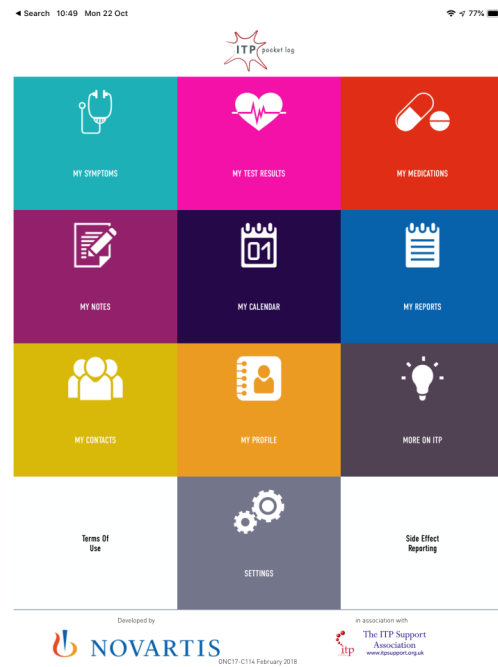
The ITP Pocket Log App 'My Symptoms' Screen
