The ITPSA has been providing ITP patients and family members with reliable information and support through its many channels (website and social media), publications, regular patient meetings and annual conferences. During these difficult times we realise that many ITP patients and their families are finding it a struggle financially whilst living with a chronic disorder, which is why we at the ITPSA have launched its scholarship fund. We also believe that education is the key to success.

Who is Eligible for the Scholarship?

Awards are restricted to Sixth Form students, current College or University students, or adults who have gone back into full time education *(as of September 2022)* who have ITP (Immune Thrombocytopenia).

How to Apply?

Please provide an 800-to-1000-word essay which details how your ITP has resulted in your growth as a person; what you learned about your own strengths and weaknesses. Tell us about your ITP Journey. Please note the winning entries will be published in the Platelet Journal and on the ITP Support Association website and Social Media Channels.

If you feel that having a chronic illness such as ITP has helped you choose a career path, describe how, and explain why you feel this way and what you have done to meet these educational goals. Explain what your plans are for the future in meeting your educational responsibilities, in light of your struggles with a platelet disorder. Remember when you are writing your essay to include your name only on the application and NOT in the body of the essay.



An application (email submission preferred) must be submitted to the ITP Support Association no earlier than 19th August 2022 and no later than 16th September 2022. The winners will be notified by 26th September 2022.

Incomplete or late Applications will not be considered.

Scholarship award winners will be announced at the start of ITP Awareness Week (w/c 26th September 2022). The essays and applications will be reviewed and judged by an impartial panel selected by the ITPSA Board.

Scholarship Funds

Scholarship Funds will be awarded with a one-time payment as follows during the academic year.

First prize: £1,500
 Second prize: £750

In addition, three (3) third place winners will be awarded £250 each for textbooks payable to the individual winners upon presentation of receipts.

*The ITPSA reserves the right to change eligibility criteria yearly and does not guarantee the availability of scholarship awards annually.
